

Belle en Rouge Appliqué Fabric Chart

Use four fabrics with a lot of white space in the print for the vases (medallion and the four appliqué corner squares).

Arrange Fabrics 1-4 from dark to light.

Use fourteen fabrics that read as red with a wide variety in texture, scale, shade and value.

Fabrics 6-19 will be used for clamshells, piecing, leaves and flowers. Fabric 6 will also be used for vines.

Use three of the darkest reds for the lemon-shaped leaves in the medallion and four appliqué corner squares.
