

My Magical Garden Appliqué Fabric Chart

Note: Color (in Parentheses) is the color used in the sample quilt. Change as desired.
For example: Your Color "C" may be pink where the sample quilt has purple.

Use five shades of
Color A (green)
from light to dark

Use four shades of
Color B (blue)
from light to dark

Use five shades of
Color C (purple)
from light to dark

Use two shades of
Color D (pink)
from light to dark

Use two shades of
Color E (yellow)
from light to dark



1—Color A Light - ½ yd



6—Color B Light - ½ yd



10—Color C Light - Fat ¼



15—Color D Light - Fat ¼



17—Color E Light - Fat ¼



2—Color A Medium Light - ½ yd



7—Color B Medium - Fat ¼



11—Color C Medium Light - Fat ¼



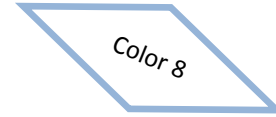
16—Color D Dark - Fat ¼

- Make sure there are differences in value, texture and/or shade within each color group. For example: find five distinct greens for the leaves and vines. They can be yellow green, moss green, and forest green in the same quilt.
- Color chart is for appliqué fabrics only. Yardage is for rotary cut appliqué. Purchase a little more for appliqué by hand.
