



Clam Shell Pillow Rotary Cut Appliqué Zoom Class

Supply List

Class Description: In this class you will make a pillow size clam shell quilt sample. Pillow finishing instructions are included in the class, but we will not finish the project.

Machine stitching around the fused appliqué shapes is part of the class. Sewing machine required.

Required Supplies:

- Hearts and More Template D*
- Grace TrueGrips*
- 28mm rotary cutter with a brand new blade**
- Rotary cutting mat, flat or rotating
- Standard class supplies: pencil, notebook, scissors, 24" straight edge acrylic ruler
- Thread to match appliqué
- Sewing machine in good working order. Be prepared to stitch a buttonhole (blanket) stitch or a zigzag
- Chalk wheel with brush away chalk* or Chalk Line with Iron Erase chalk or both!
- Glow line tape** or quarter inch tape. Use painter's tape if you can't get quarter inch tape.



Yardage Requirements:

- Clam Shells: eight (8) 11" squares print fabric
- 1 ½ yards Mistyfuse, 20" wide or fusible of your choice (do not use Steam a Seam II)
- Background: One (1) 22" square background color
- Optional: Sixteen (16) 4" squares of background color (for optional bonus quilt blocks)

Supplies needed to complete the pillow but not needed for class:

- Backing: Two (2) 21 ½" X 13" backing fabric rectangles
- 22" square batting of your choice
- 20" x 20" pillow form

Homework must be completed prior to class:

Pre-wash all fabrics. Apply fusible on the back of the 11" squares using an appliqué pressing sheet. I use the Fat Goddess Sheet by Mistyfuse**
