

**Class Description:** Learn how the Leaves Galore templates can help you rotary cut appliqué in no time. There will be no sewing in class, just cutting, fusing and creating!! Decorative machine stitching after class will be required to complete the project.

**Required Supplies:**

- Leaves Galore Petite template\*
- Grace TrueGrips\*
- \*Use mine in class for \$5 fee. Fee is refundable if you decide to purchase the templates in class.**
- 28mm rotary cutter with a brand new blade\*\*
- Standard cutting mat at least 12" x 18"
- Standard class supplies: pencil, notebook, scissors, straight edge acrylic ruler
- Frixion Marking Pen\*
- Chalk wheel with brush away chalk\*\*
- Optional: Pattern Cutting Board (maybe you have one in your sewing room or garage! This is a cardboard fold up board used to protect your table top when cutting dress patterns). Don't go out and buy this, but pull yours out if you have one.



**Yardage Requirements:**

- One vine fabric for border: 6" x 22"
- Eight leaf or melon fabrics for quilt center: 4" x 22" - Of these Eight, it is nice to have some greens that you can repeat for the leaves in the border
- Three flower fabrics: 5" x 8" - It is best to use some of the same fabrics as the melon fabrics
- Background and Borders: 1 ¼ yds (dark fabrics look great too!)
- Fusible: 1 ½ yds x 20" wide fusible
- Binding: ½ yd
- Batting and Backing: 1 ½ yds (not needed for class but needed to complete your quilt)

**Homework must be completed prior to class:**

Pre-wash all fabrics for quilt top. Pre-fuse all vine, leaf (melon), and flower fabrics with Mistyfuse. Do not use Steam a Seam II. Mistyfuse\* is preferred.
