

**Supply List**

**Class Description:**

Make a Promise Ring Quilt that is 28" x 28". Several new techniques are explored including eight petal flowers, rings, scalloped edges and bias binding. Another optional technique that can be explored is buttonhole stitching through all three layers. This option gives you a quilted look with out Machine Quilting and makes this a quick, easy project. Use Christmas fabrics and add bling to make this a Christmas quilt or use your favorite color combination for a bright cheery quilt that works in any season.

**Supplies:**

- Leaves Galore Templates, Petite and Grande\*
- Grace TrueGrips\*
- 28mm rotary cutter with a brand new blade\*\*
- Rotary cutting mat at least 18 x 24
- Standard class supplies: pencil, notebook, scissors, 24" straight edge acrylic ruler
- Thread to match appliqué
- Sewing machine in good working order. Be prepared to stitch a buttonhole (blanket) stitch or a zigzag
- Chalk wheel with brush away chalk\*\*
- Promise Ring Pattern\*\* (highly recommended, but not required)



Finished Quilt: 28" x 28"



**Yardage Requirements:**

- 1 yard background
- Fat quarter for binding
- 9" x 22" for rings
- 1/3 yard total for leaves (can use several greens)
- 1/3 yard total for flowers (can use several colors)
- 1 yard backing
- Mistyfuse, 4 yards 20" wide
- Batting: 32" x 32" (use cotton if quilting and applique stitching in one step)

**Homework must be completed prior to class:**  
Pre-wash all fabrics. Pre-fuse appliqué fabrics with Mistyfuse.
